This section contains the answer keys for the crossword puzzles and word searches. Please note that words that contain beginnings such as "la" or "le" have no space between them - so "el niño" will be "elniño" on the puzzle.

Many of the pages - such as the numbers and numeracy order are very repetitious and tedious, so these you may want to simply use as reference, or do only one page per day, instead of the whole set at once. Perhaps add other vocabulary and phrases to make it more meaningful.

Other pages, such as the seasons, days and holiday greetings, have extra space for adding names, phrases, and your own dialogue with the greeting.

With the carols and prayers, translations are not given for the students so that you can print one page for them to copy in Spanish and then a second page for them to translate, giving you an additional two lessons for each.

There are several pages with common Spanish phrases and sayings. These pages have the most common translation given, but please know that many of them have more than one meaning, which is often quite similar.

The greetings and farewells are a great way to practice dialogue. There are very basic phrases - both formal and informal, given.

Much of the Spanish language encompasses several different countries, and therefore, several different dialects, as well as phrases that have different meanings, depending on to whom you are speaking. With this in mind, I have tried to keep words and phrases as the most universal for the Spanish language.

We hope that you enjoy this copybook for your students. If you would like to share with others, please direct them to where they may purchase it, but do not share this file.

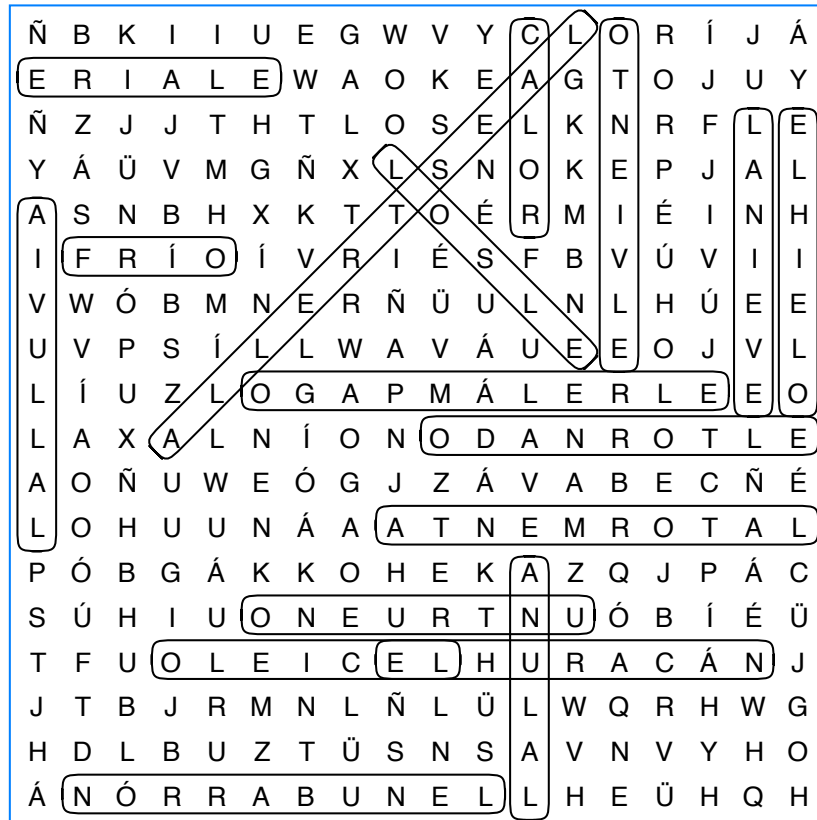
